SCIENTIFIC PERMIT

This permit authorizes Sergei Drovetski, University of Alaska Anchorage, Dept. of Biological Sciences  
(person, agency or organization)  
of 3211 Providence Dr., Anchorage, AK 99508 to conduct the following  
(address)  
activities from February 1, 2007 to December 31, 2007 in accordance with AS 16.05.930.

Authority is granted permittee to take migratory birds in the number listed for each species on federal permit MB795841 as necessary for the development of an avian collection for the Department of Biological Sciences, University of Alaska Anchorage. Also authorized to import, export, transport, salvage, and possess specimens for scientific and educational purposes. Salvaged birds may not have been killed by the permittee or subpermittees. The use of unattended mist nets is *not* authorized. Collecting for other research facilities and educational institutions is *not* authorized.

The primary permittee may designate subpermittees to conduct activities authorized by this permit. The primary permittee is responsible for the actions of all subpermittees and for ensuring their compliance with the conditions of this permit. Persons conducting activities authorized by this permit are exempt from fish and game licensing requirements of AS 16.05.330.

An annual report of activities must be submitted electronically on a form provided by the department by the date specified below. Electronic submission in an alternate format is acceptable provided the following information is included: the date and location of all captures and recaptures; sex, age, and final disposition of captured animals; names of subpermittees, and a brief description of the progress and accomplishments of the study to date. Copies of all interim, progress and final reports and published manuscripts resulting from activities conducted under authority of this permit shall be submitted to the Alaska Department of Fish and Game, Division of Wildlife Conservation, Permit Section, P.O. Box 115526, Juneau, AK 99811-5526.

**THIS PERMIT AND VALID FEDERAL PERMITS MUST BE IN POSSESSION WHILE CONDUCTING COLLECTING ACTIVITIES.**

REPORT DUE January 31, 2008. The report shall include the information specified above.

GENERAL CONDITIONS, EXCEPTIONS AND RESTRICTIONS

1. This permit must be carried by person(s) specified during approved activities who shall show it on request to persons authorized to enforce Alaska's fish and game laws. This permit is nontransferable and will be revoked or renewal denied by the Commissioner of Fish and Game if the permittee violates any of its conditions, exceptions or restrictions. No redelegation of authority may be allowed under this permit unless specifically noted.
2. No specimens taken under authority hereof may be sold or bartered. All specimens must be deposited in a public museum or a public scientific or educational institution unless otherwise stated herein. Subpermittees shall not retain possession of live animals or other specimens.
3. The permittee shall keep records of all activities conducted under authority of this permit, available for inspection at all reasonable hours upon request of any authorized state enforcement officer.
4. Permits will not be renewed until detailed reports, as specified above, have been received by the department.
5. UNLESS SPECIFICALLY STATED HEREIN, THIS PERMIT DOES NOT AUTHORIZE the exportation of specimens or the taking of specimens in areas otherwise closed to hunting and fishing; without appropriate licenses required by state regulations; during closed seasons; or in any manner, by any means, at any time not permitted by those regulations.
